SEAMLESS: Three exhibitions of contemporary textiles

In *seamless*, Object Gallery presents three interweaving exhibitions that focus on the possibilities of textile art. ***a matter of time: the 16th Tamworth Fibre Textile Biennial*** presents objects made by 25 artists, all of whom place textiles at the centre of their work. In ***Visible Darning***, leading textile artist, Liz Williamson, reclaims the least visible of all textile processes: darning. In Object Gallery's Window space, ***8 Ounces*** presents the unusual crochet of emerging talent, Ahn Wells.
